As a group, our cohort has shared several suggestions for the pilot course throughout the past 20 months. Suggestions for improvement include not offering 660 during intense student courses, offering a weekly group discussion for students to connect, offering guest speakers throughout the program, and offering more of an opportunity to learn practical technology through this program. Current students and alumni have stated that the one weakness of this LDT program is an inability to learn and practice authoring tools and other technology. The first mission of many graduates is to learn authoring tools and video software. Programs like Articulate are not going away. Having an opportunity to use 660, not just to polish portfolio materials, but to learn technology would be extremely practical and beneficial. This could be accomplished by reducing the number of badges that students must complete to essential must have portfolio items, and creating project-based 660 quarters that allow students to complete a project using an authoring tool or technology.
