1	The weekly emails & videos were helpful to keep me on track. It was helpful to know what was expected each week. I was also glad she shared about what she was doing personally in these emails. It made her feel more approachable.
2	She was great at communicating and being available.
3	She is very responsive when you have a question and responds quickly through email. She is also very open to staying in touch for questions after the class is over.
4	Professor Fiock explains requirements and expectations clearly. I like how she shares elements of her life outside of class. This helps me have a picture that she is a real person. I like how Professor will guide you in a direction when she is not sure of the answer she has a skill set to help you find out what you need.
5	Instructor was fine. Didn't act very knowledgeable about trends and theories within the field. This is a one hour course, and she took it way too seriously. The discussions and responses were ridiculous, as I got penalized for completing this assignment earlier than she "wanted". Students have outside lives, jobs, families and we should not be penalized for completing work early. If responses were not spaced out a day apart, there would be a penalty, and that is not stated anywhere within the syllabus. After the midterm survey, she addressed this in a video that was very passive aggressive. I would not enjoy taking another class from her. This class needs to be taken out of the program curriculum, it adds no value to the program.

I would love to get my money back because I didn't get anything out of this. Complete waste of my time and money, I am very disappointed that the program would want to waste my time and money with this irrelevant class.
2	The toughest part of this course was achieving the badges. Because I live in a area with limited access to internet it would take a large amount of time and sometime a couple of days to complete the task.
3	The directions and deadlines for the group project were initially hard to find. I would suggest posting them on the BrightSpace page in addition to having them in the document.
4	Several of the links to articles were broken or out of date. It might be helpful to double-check and update them as needed, or provide alternate links to similar materials.
5	Personally I did not feel like the "badges" we had to earn were beneficial to me, and I would consider a different form of multimodal assignment instead. I also was very overwhelmed during week 6 of this course - the majority of us are also taking the Theories & Trends course and having a group project due in both of these courses on the same day was a lot to handle. If you are going to keep giving this group project I know I would've appreciated these assignments not having the same due dates.
