

- I did not find any problems with this course. It was very beneficial as a new graduate student
- I think that some of the APA assignments and plagiarism assignments were a bit much. It truly felt like busy work and was frustrating that some of them were so time consuming. I do find it beneficial to have a quick assignment in regards to both of those topics but not as much as we did. I also didn't find the technology badge assignment to be useful as I was already proficient in those areas so perhaps some type of self-evaluation where you could bypass that work would be helpful in the future.
- I cannot think of any ways to improve the course.
- I feel the course load and time required for completing the weekly objective were appropriately gauged for the course.
- Have a pre-survey or pre-test for levels of knowledge with technology resources discussed in the online badge. The things on the intro badge are programs that are almost required to be a teacher in the 21st century. It would've been more helpful to learn new resources.

- John Dewey said that we don't learn from experience; we learn from reflecting on our experience. The mandatory discussion posts were difficult because I found that instead of reflecting more on our learning, the mandatory reply posts were evaluating and judging each other's thoughts. As a learner, I try to avoid that because I feel that the true learning moment is when we honestly and openly evaluate ourselves, not others.
